- Require Retainage to be Held in 3rd Party Accounts with Interest Paid & Released Upon Completion
- Individual Lot Accounting for Residential Construction
- Prohibit Indemnity Transfer Via Contract or Insurance Policy
- Improve Lien Effectiveness as a Collection Tool & Extend the 1-Year Expiration Date

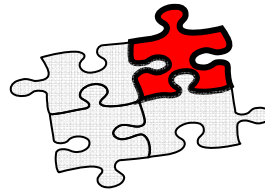
